Background

A Fortune 500 pharmaceutical company engaged SC&H Group to review transactions with their general contractor building a clean room facility. SC&H worked directly with the general contractor to obtain transaction details and validate compliance. The review was completed in roughly 60 days.



Overview of Terms

Key contract terms included:

- » Actual wage rate plus mark-up for project labor
- » General contractor home office personnel and expenses were non-billable
- » Fixed percentage fee on direct construction costs
- » Subcontractor costs passed through without mark-up



Audit Results

The client recovered non-compliant charges totaling \$900,000, roughly 4.5% of the total spend during the audit period.
